

Beaver Valley Bruce Trail Club raises \$100K for land

Beaver Valley Bruce Trail Club received a special kudos during a recent celebration by the Bruce Trail Conservancy, which marked \$2.9 million raised this past year for the Niagara Escarpment land preservation and conservation.

The local trail club raised \$100,000 of that total.

The Club has connected with the local community and its local members to hold various fundraisers and events, to raise the \$100,000 this year.

“It speaks to the commitment and generosity of the many, many of our members over time,” said Beaver Valley Bruce Trail Club president Ros Rossetti. “Our members and volunteers are inspired and motivated by Bruce Trail Conservancy’s goal to secure, protect and conserve trail lands.”

Currently, the Conservancy is working on a goal to secure and steward 5,000 new acres of Niagara Escarpment land containing the Bruce Trail.

Already, Beaver Valley is seeing this goal in action, as three new parcels of land were added to the local trail as nature reserves, including 74 acres in Epping, 57 acres in Kimberley, and 128 acres in Kolapore.
