Once again Council chose to ignore the community and voted to approve the by-law to sell the upper and lower portions of the land. However, we remain hopeful as land preservation is a long road and this is just a slight pothole.

Don't lose hope! An emergency court filing has been made to the Superior Court to reverse the by-law on the basis that Council did not follow their own policies. This February 9th court date is simply the first in a many-pronged strategic approach that will be taken through the courts and through other areas like planning processes.
